

General Instructions and Sample Question Paper for Entrance Exam for Admission to MBA

1. The written exam will be of objective type divided into 4 sections as follows;
 - (a) Section I Reasoning (Verbal and well as Non-verbal)
 - (b) Section II General English
 - (c) Section III General Awareness
 - (d) Section IV Business Awareness
2. Each section will contain 25 questions of 1 mark each and the duration of the exam will be 2 Hours.
3. There will be NO negative marking for wrong or unanswered questions.
4. Rough sheets will be provided at the end of each question paper for rough work. The candidate should ensure that he / she does not write anywhere else on the question paper except the rough sheets.
5. Use of pencil will not be allowed and cutting, erasing, over-marking or multiple marking of answers will lead to cancellation of that question.
6. Use of calculator (Both scientific as well as non-scientific) will not be permitted
